THREE OAKS RENEWABLE ENERGY PARK EXTENSION PLANNING APPLICATION</b><br/> <b>26/01388/STPLFE</b> – Erection of a wind farm consisting of 6 turbines (149.9m to tip and 91.4m to hub), 1 met mast (91.4m high), installation of underground cabling, transformer kiosks, construction of crane pads, access tracks and widening of existing vehicular access and associated works [Turbine 1 – 510534, N465648; Turbine 2 – 511084, N465710; Turbine 3 – E511722, N465975; Turbine 4 – E510722, N464846; Turbine 5 – E511340, N465110; Turbine 6 – 511771, N465303 and Met Mat E510941 – N 464790] at Thornholme Fields, Rudston Road, Burton Agnes YO25 4NE for Three Oaks REP Extension Ltd.<br/> Circulated via email 21/07/2026. Comments deadline 13/08/2026.<br/> There were no comments on the planning portal from residents within the parish of Burton Agnes, although Cllr. Bliss advised that comments had been submitted but, due to holidays, had not yet been published. A previous planning application had been refused on a number of grounds, including an objection from the Ministry of Defence, and these concerns remain relevant to the current application. Other concerns included protection of the land and potential contamination of the aquifer, the noise and vibration survey being based on a desk-top study, potential damage to the highway network, and construction-related disturbance, including dust and noise. Cllr. Harrison has identified seven main points of concern in a separate document, which will be circulated to all councillors for any amendments or additions.<br/> <b>RESOLVED:</b> Cllr. Cossins proposed, Cllr. Palmer seconded, and all were in favour of submitting an objection to the application on behalf of Burton Agnes Parish Council, based on the concerns raised at the meeting.</p> <p><b>5.
