PLANNING 5.1 Planning Applications: 5.1.1 256/01388/STPLFE – Erection of a wind farm consisting of 6 turbines (149.9m to tip and 91.4m to hub), 1 met mast (91.4m high), installation of underground cabling, transformer kiosks, construction of crane pads, access tracks and widening of existing vehicular access and associated works [Turbine 1 – 510534, N465648; Turbine 2 – 511084, N465710; Turbine 3 – E511722, N465975; Turbine 4 – E510722, N464846; Turbine 5 – E511340, N465110; Turbine 6 – 511771, N465303 and Met Mat E510941 – N 464790] at Thornholme Fields, Rudston Road, Burton Agnes YO25 4NE for Three Oaks REP Extension Ltd. Circulated via email 21/07/2026. Comments deadline 13/08/2026.
